

Producer Incentive Guide

The programme pays verified producers an incentive **above market price** for adopting and maintaining climate-smart practices on land they already farm.

What you are paid

Rate	\$0.30 per pound above market price
Cap per producer	Up to 20,000 lbs per farmer
Producers supported	Up to 150 farmers across the programme
Payment timing	Paid each January, after harvest
Total pool	\$2,400,000 across the life of the grant

Practices the programme supports

Reduced chemical inputs · improved pasture and grazing management · ground-cover and soil-health practices · conservation planning with your local district.

How verification works

Fields are verified using **WORMS — Working on Regenerative Management Systems**, a field-data tool built on ESRI Survey123 by Oklahoma NRCS and the Oklahoma Conservation Commission. Verifiers record water infiltration, ground cover, soil structure and biomass, and are trained through Murray State College's certification course.

Before you enrol, gather

Your FSA Farm ID, Tract ID and Field ID; the state and county tied to that Farm ID; your producer name exactly as it appears on your USDA Business Partner record; commodity type with acreage or pounds; and your AD-1026 conservation-compliance certification status with a current-year Subsidiary Print.

These identifiers must match your existing federal records. Enrolment cannot be completed from a name and phone number alone.
